Listed below are some of the frequently asked questions regarding our workshop. Please read the questions and answers so that your pupils and school receive the maximum benefit when attending the event.

Q: What age group is this workshop is designed for?

A: It is aimed at pupils from primary (Y5-Y6), secondary (Y9-Y11) and sixth form.

Q: What time do the workshops start?

A: 9:30am, 10:00am or 10:30am (from experience the workshops are more effective in the morning).

Q: What do pupils need to bring?

A: Pen / pencil and notepad or paper and an open mind.

Q: What space or venue is required to facilitate the workshop?

A: School hall, or similar sized room is imperative (please note workshop can not take place without the appropriate space).



Q: Is a class teacher required to be present when the workshop takes place?

A: Yes, a member of the school staff is expected to be in attendance to oversee the proceedings and to act as an additional point of communication between the workshop tutor and the pupils.

Q: How many pupils can attend each tutorial?

A: Maximum number of participants for each session is 30.

Q: What is the time duration of the workshop?

A: The school should allocate at least two hours.

Q: What level of experience and expertise of photography is required by the pupils?

A: Ideally attendees should have a basic understanding of photography, however not essential.

Q: Do the pupils need their own camera?


A: No, the equipment we bring allows everyone to participate. Please note no phones are to be brought to the workshop.
