FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: What ages are your workshops aimed towards?

A: Our research suggests pupils in years 5 & 6 and years 10 & 11 will benefit most from our workshops.

Q: Why do you target these specific age groups?

A: Parents and teachers noted that on average, children between the ages of 8-11 begin understanding the concept of money. Furthermore, we feel that children aged 15-16 should receive a specific introduction in to the world of personal finance. Giving your pupils advanced knowledge in to targeted areas of money.

Q: How many pupils can we put forward to attend your workshops?

A: For each pupil to get the very most out of the workshop, we suggest a group of no more than 30 should be in attendance.

Q: What space would you require?
